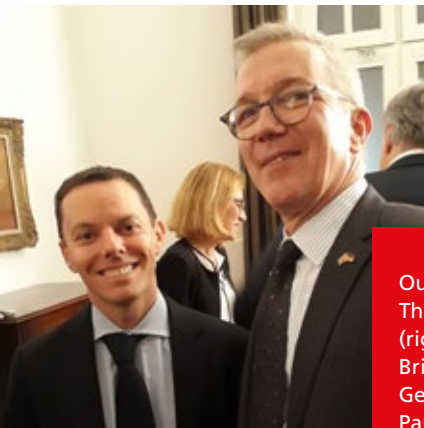
The Deutsch-Britische Gesellschaft München e.V. offers you the opportunity to find out about various Anglo-German topics through a regular programme of talks and events.

March 21 In English	Linda Goodwin – Intercultural Challenges: Being A Success in an International Environment. Speaking a common language is a prerequisite, but not an indicator of how successful one will be when working cross-cultures.
April 24 In English	Rachel Launay: Germany and the UK post-Brexit – Where does the Soft Power of Culture and Education go from here? Rachel is Country Director of the British Council Germany and will look at what motivates German millennials (aged 18-34) to engage with the UK.
May 2 In deutscher Sprache	Die Historikerin Karina Urbach alias Hannah Coler liest aus ihrem Spionageroman über die berühmten "Cambridge 5".
May 17 In English	Stephen Patterson from the Royal Collection: Queen Victoria and Germany, travels with her sketchbook. The British Royal Collection is one of the finest collections of art in the world.
June 4 In English	Roger Thomas: The Hunt for Saddam's Weapons of Mass Destruction A former British diplomat, Roger headed the team of British analysts and weapons experts looking for and destroying Iraqi WMD after the First Gulf War. What did they find?

October 16 In English	Boyd McCleary: Brexit – Why Is It Happening and What Will It Mean? A British diplomat for over 40 years, Boyd will set out the background to Brexit and explain why the British voted to leave, and what the implications will be.
November 21 In deutscher Sprache	Gertraud Heinrich: Briten im Orient. John Frederick Lewis und Künstlerkollegen der englischen Malerei des 19. Jh. Ein Blick auf den Orient, wie ihn vier britische Maler des 19. Jahrhunderts für sich selbst entwickelten.
