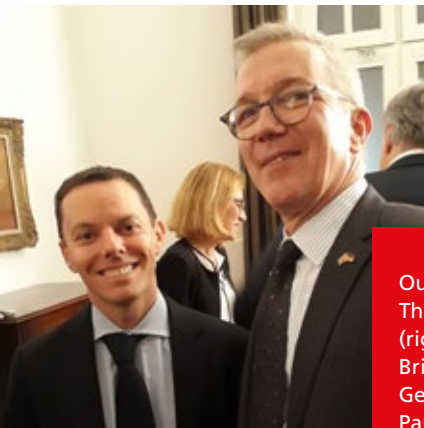
The Deutsch-Britische Gesellschaft München e.V. offers you the opportunity to find out about various Anglo-German topics through a regular programme of talks and events.
